DA's Crimes Against Property Team tries 2 defendants

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – The Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Crimes Against Property Team tried two defendants July 21-28, 2014, in Mecklenburg County Superior Court. The trials were held in courtroom 5150 before The Honorable Eric L. Levinson, Superior Court Judge.

Shawn Davis, 43, was tried for three counts of felonious possession of stolen goods. The jury found him *guilty* of two counts of possession of stolen goods and *not guilty* of the remaining count. Davis will be sentenced at a later date.

Bethea Douglas, 41, was tried for two counts of breaking or entering a motor vehicle. The jury returned verdicts of *not guilty*.
