## DA's Office raises awareness of domestic violence with Steps for Change

CHARLOTTE, N.C. – Marching through the streets of uptown Charlotte today, prosecutors, domestic violence survivors and concerned members of the community spread awareness of a critical issue affecting families across Mecklenburg County.

More than 120 people participated in the Fourth Annual Steps for Change Domestic Violence Awareness Walk, hosted by the Mecklenburg County District Attorney's Office. All proceeds from the event benefited Safe Alliance's Clyde and Ethel Dickson Shelter, an 80-bed facility that houses victims of domestic violence. Safe Alliance, a nonprofit, also provides services such as safety planning, support groups, legal advocacy and life skills training for domestic violence victims in Mecklenburg County.
